

## LOUDOUN COUNTY COURTHOUSE EXPANSION

The project is part of an expansion of the courts complex and includes the design and construction of a new 92,000-square-foot courthouse, renovation of the existing courthouse and historic Valley Bank building as well as improved parking and pedestrian access to the courts buildings.

### **Work Hours:**

### **Construction Timeline:**

Construction is scheduled to begin in January 2020 and is expected to last approximately 2.5 years. Below is an estimated timeline of the project.
