Preregistration & Open Registration

For Daze, Fest, Adaptive Recreation Camp & Licensed Community/Recreation Center Camps

Preregistration for returning families (2021 participants in Daze, Fest, Adaptive Recreation and licensed summer camps at community/recreation centers) begins March 8 at 8:30 a.m. and ends March 11 at 5 p.m. Registration for families eligible for the free and reduced lunch program at LCPS begins March 15 at 8:30 a.m. and ends March 18 at 5 p.m. Open registration for remaining spaces begins March 22 at 8:30 a.m. and ends April 30 at 11:59 p.m. Additional paperwork may be required to meet licensing requirements. Returning families will be notified in advance. New registrants will be notified upon registration. Visit www.loudoun.gov/camps, email camp@loudoun.gov for Daze and Fest inquiries or contact your desired community/recreation center for more information. For Adaptive Recreation Camp inquire email adaptiverecreationcamp@loudoun.gov To establish a new household account or retrieve existing household information, visit www.loudoun.gov/webtrac before the start of registration. Registration is ongoing until spaces are filled.

General Camp Registration

County residents may register online for all other PRCS summer camps beginning at 12:01 a.m. March 22 or in person at PRCS Administration and center and park offices during normal operating hours. To establish a new household account or retrieve existing household information, visit www.loudoun.gov/webtrac prior to the start of registration. Registration is ongoing until spaces are filled.

Non-Resident Registration

Camp registration for anyone residing outside of Loudoun County begins March 29.

Payments

Registration fees are due at the time of registration, unless otherwise noted. Online registrations must be paid by credit card. Cash, check, money order or credit card payments can be made in person. Checks or money orders must be made payable to “County of Loudoun.” Your driver’s license number must be included on the check. Do not include supply fees in the total paid. Supply fees are payable to the instructor at the first day of camp.

Notice to Participants

All activities of a physical nature involve some risk. By registering for a county-sponsored class requiring physical activity, you, as the participant or parent of a participant under the age of 18, assume the risk involved in participating in these activities. The Loudoun County Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services is dedicated to providing safe facilities and equipment for all participants, as well as qualified instructional staff to enhance your experience.

Unless specifically declined, by registering for or participating in a PRCS-sponsored activity, participants give permission for the Loudoun County Department of Parks, Recreation and Community

Services to use photographs and videos of themselves or their children for publicity in publications and other media, including social media, without limitation in order to increase community awareness of PRCS programs and services.

Supplies & Materials

The cost of supplies and materials is included in the camp fee, unless otherwise noted. If a separate supply or material fee is required, it must be paid to the instructor on the first day of camp.

Transportation

Spaces are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Transportation form requests will not be sent to families until all other camp forms and documents are complete.

Trip Policy

There will be no smoking or alcoholic beverages allowed on any vehicles used for department trips, including motor buses. Due to outside costs associated with arranging and booking trips, there will be no refund when a participant cancels a trip registration.

Program Accessibility/ADA

The Loudoun County Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services is committed to complying with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). If you require a reasonable accommodation for any type of disability in order to participate in PRCS activities, please email adaptrec@loudoun.gov.

Program Refunds & Cancellations

Our goal is to ensure quality programs. If you are dissatisfied with the quality of a camp while the participant is enrolled, you may request a refund according to the following policy: Refund requests must include an explanation of why the participant is disappointed with the quality of the camp. The request must be dated and sent by email directly to the facility manager or program manager offering the camp. The amount of refund will be prorated based on the number of remaining sessions. If you make the request 15 or more days before the camp starts, a full refund, MINUS a 15% administrative fee (maximum of \$15), will be offered. If you cancel a registration 14 or fewer days before the start date, a refund of 50% will be offered.

The Department reserves the right to cancel or change a camp or activity due to insufficient enrollment or other reasonable cause. A full refund (including any applicable registration fee) will be offered.

Closings/Postponements

In case of inclement weather, public holidays or emergencies, the Department will determine cancellation or postponement of programs. If you are in doubt as to whether or not camp activities will be held, please contact the location or program offering the camp or call 703-777-0343.

REGISTRATION

Returning Camp families: For families registered in summer 2021 you may pre-register for the summer of 2022 during pre-registration from March 8 at 8:30am – March 11 at 5pm

Free & Reduced Lunch: Preregistration families participating in the Loudoun County Public Schools Free and Reduced Lunch Program runs from 8:30 a.m. on March 15 until 5 p.m. on March 18. Proof of participation is required upon registration (Free and reduced lunch approval letter for 2021-22 school year).

New Families: General registration for Summer Camps opens March 22, at 8:30am, online.

A \$25 per child, per week non-refundable deposit is due at registration.
