Riding Fees

Drop in use is first-come-first-served and FREE

Park Rules

- 1. Alcohol is prohibited on park premises
- 2. Dogs must be leashed and under control while on park property.
- 3. Natural Resources are protected. Do not disturb animal or plant life in any way
- 4. Do not feed wildlife
- 5. It is illegal to release any animals into the park
- 6. Smoking is not permitted in any park buildings or Sportsplex
- 7. Park Staff must be notified in the event of an accident or incident or if the Sheriff, Fire or Rescue Department is called to the park for any reason
- 8. All amenities are first come first served, unless otherwise reserved
- 9. No person shall use a metal detector or similar device within a park or facility site without the express written permission of the Department Director or designee
- 10. Remote Control Devices and engine powered models, machines, or toys
 - a. Remote control planes, helicopters, boats, cars, or other like devices may only be operated if there is designated area for such an activity at a PRCS site
 - b. Hobby Rockets, take-off/landing of flying machines or balloons are not permitted at PRCS sites
- 11. Personal fireworks and sparklers are prohibited by order of the Fire Marshal, including July 4th activities.
- 12. All outdoor facilities close when lightning is seen and will remain closed until twenty minutes have passed since the last clap of thunder

Pond Rules

- 1. No swimming
- 2. No boats allowed including kayaks and canoes
- 3. An adult must supervise children 12 & under
- 4. Anyone 16 and older must hold a valid Virginia Fishing License
- 5. All state game laws apply
- 6. Wading is not permitted
- 7. Netting is not allowed in pond
- 8. Pets are not permitted in the pond
- 9. No person shall go upon the ice on any body of water in the park

Dog Park Rules

- 1. All dogs must be licensed, have current vaccinations, and must wear a collar with ID tags
- 2. Dogs must be on leash when entering and exiting
- 3. Please close all gates when entering and exiting
- 4. Please watch your dog at all times Do not leave dogs unattended

- 5. All use of off-leash area is at your own risk
- 6. Children under 13 must be supervised by an adult
- 7. All waste must be removed, bags are provided
- 8. Discourage barking or digging If your dog digs a hole, please fill it in
- 9. Aggressive dogs are not allowed
- 10. Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted
- 11. Smoking and food are not permitted in the off-leash area

Dogs in Parks

Dogs are generally allowed in parks while on a physical leash and under the control of the owner, according to <u>Chapter 612.13</u> of the <u>Loudoun County Codified Ordinances</u>; however, per <u>Chapter 1092.21</u>, there are certain areas within parks that dogs are prohibited, such as **sports fields** and their surrounding areas. Please see the ordinance language for both <u>612.13</u> and <u>1092.21</u> for more details.

Sports Complex Rules

- 1. Dogs are prohibited from athletic fields, spectator areas, and sports complexes
- 2. Guide animals are permitted in all areas of the park
- 3. Alcohol is prohibited on park premises
- 4. Smoking is not permitted on athletic fields or within sports complexes
- 5. Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, etc. are not allowed on athletic fields or within sports complexes and parking lots
- 6. All outdoor facilities close when lightning is seen and will remain closed until twenty minutes have passed since the last clap of thunder
- 7. Athletic field open/closed statuses are posted online daily at RainOutLine.com

Equestrian Rules

- Drop-in use available on a first-come-first-served basis and is FREE. Ring sharing is required, and normal ring etiquette is expected.
- All riders must wear an ASTM/SEI-approved helmet while mounted anywhere in the park.
- All horses must have a current negative Coggins in accordance with Virginia State Health regulations. The Coggins must be on site and available for inspection.
- All horses traveling from outside Virginia must have a current health certificate available for inspection.
- Lessons, shows, and events must be approved through Loudoun County PRCS.

PLEASE:

- Practice lunging in designated areas only.
- Return all equestrian equipment (jumps, muck buckets, etc.) to its original location.
- Clean up droppings in ring after riding.
- Do not leave shavings or manure from trailer in parking lot.
- Pick your horses' feet prior to entering ring.
- Keep ring gates closed at all times.
- Keep dogs out of equestrian ring. Dogs must be leashed and under control while on park property.
