Winter 2022/2023 Senior Trips registration begins on Wednesday 11/09/22 at 9:00am unless otherwise noted. All trips are for individuals 55+. Transportation is by 28-passenger bus or motor coach. First price listed is for current senior center members (Ashburn, Carver, Cascades, Dulles South, and Leesburg); second price listed is for non-members. For non-members who do not live in Loudoun County registration begins on 11/16/22

Departure and return locations for trips will alternate between Ashburn Senior Center, Cascades Senior Center, Dulles South Senior Center, and Carver Senior Center. All trips will include pick-up at the Floor & Decor Store (Old Walmart) 950 Edwards Ferry Road (west side of parking lot). Return times are estimates and may vary. Sign-up is required at any PRCS Senior or Community Centers or online through WebTrac (day trips only). Registration for overnight trips is done in person.
