

## Hours are 7am to 10pm, subject to weather and skate park conditions.

- 1. Skate at your own risk. Only skateboards, skates and non-motorized scooters are allowed inside the area. Bikes, rip sticks and castor boards are not permitted.
- 2. Patrons must abide by staff instructions at all times, respect others and share the space.
- 3. All patrons are required to wear closed toe shoes and shirts at all times. Helmets and additional protective equipment, such as wrist/elbow/knee pads, are strongly recommended.
- 4. Food, glass or breakable containers are not permitted in skate area. Tobacco, drugs and alcohol are not permitted on or near the skate park. Foul language, horseplay and violence are not permitted.
- 5. Children under 12 years old must be supervised by an adult when visiting or using the facility.
- 6. Trespassing or loitering on the premises when the skate park is closed is not permitted.
- 7. The skate park is closed and may not be used in the event of inclement weather, including rain, lightning, ice and snow, or when these conditions are present.
- 8. Fighting, other aggressive, disruptive or unlawful behavior will result in ejection from the skate area, and participants may be suspended for a period of time or banned from future use.
- 9. Issues and injuries are to be reported to Park staff immediately. In case of serious injury, the injured person should not be moved, and all activities must be stopped.
- 10. Additional obstacles or other materials (such as ramps or jumps) may not be brought into or used in or around the skate park area.
- 11. Music and sound devices are not allowed, except as part of a PRCS approved event.
- 12. All organized events must have prior written permission from the Hanson Park Management Team.

By entering this facility, you agree to follow the rules above and understand the risks associated with use. Hanson Park Skate Park is owned and operated by Loudoun County through Loudoun County Parks, Recreation and Community Services. Patrons who violate the rules are subject to immediate removal from the facility, possible prosecution, and banned from future use.
