Hanson Park Trails

Hal & Berni Hanson Park offers paved walking paths connecting all of its fields, playgrounds, and other amenities in addition to the recreational hiking trails and paths around the ponds and through the wooded areas.

Types of Hiking Trails

A paved trail runs from the dog park/disc golf parking lot to the Lodge and continues in a loop around the pond behind the Nature Center.

Approximately two miles of marked mulch trails weave through the forest adjacent to the Nature Center and connect to the paved trail at three locations.

All trails are mixed use and open to walking, running, and bicycling. Horses and dirt bikes are not permitted.



What is a Tree Conservation Area?

Tree Conservation Areas (TCAs) are established by Loudoun County Parks, Recreation, and Community Services to protect trees and natural habitats. The soil, trees, and any existing vegetation must remain in the TCA. We ask park patrons to limit disturbance to this area as little as possible.
