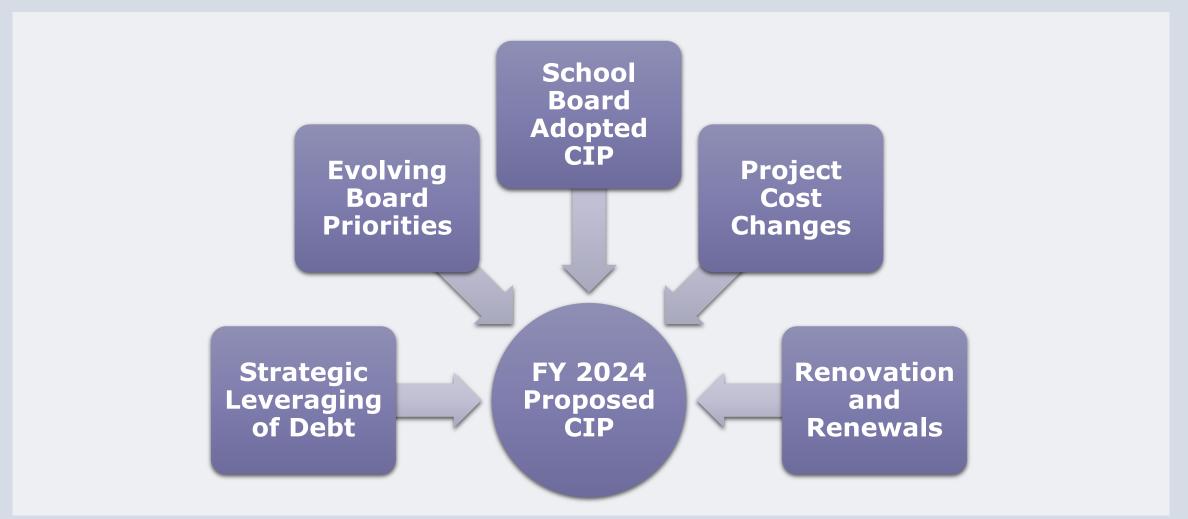




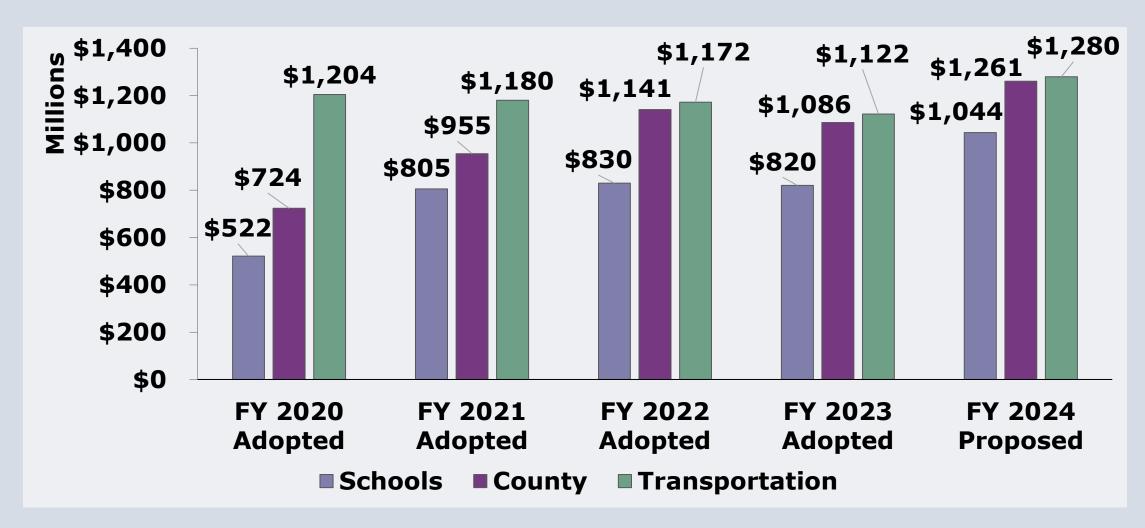




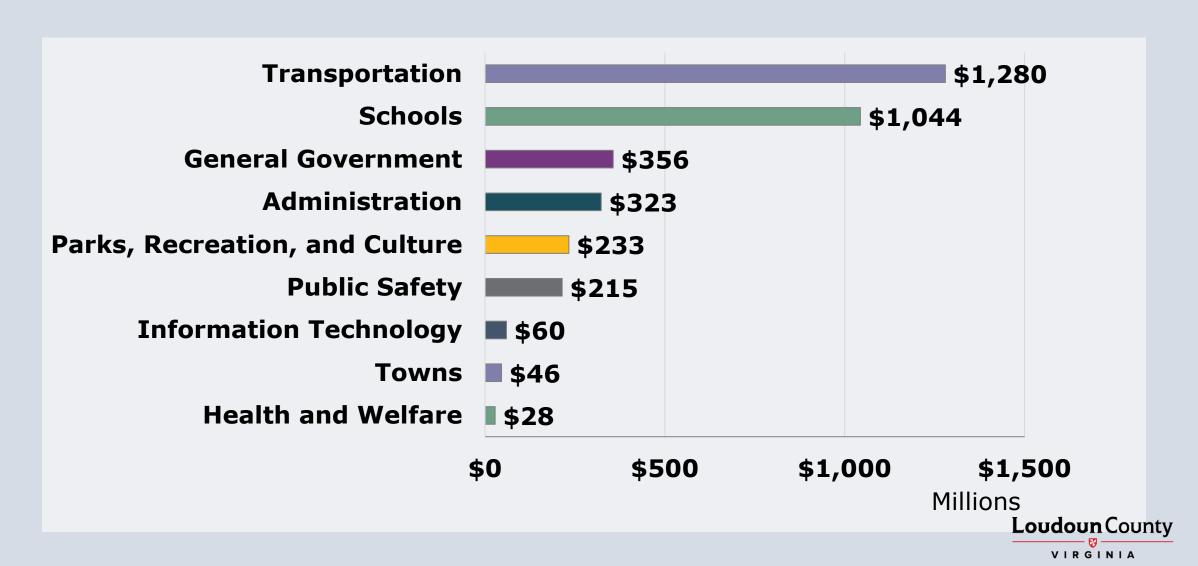
Factors Affecting Amended CIP



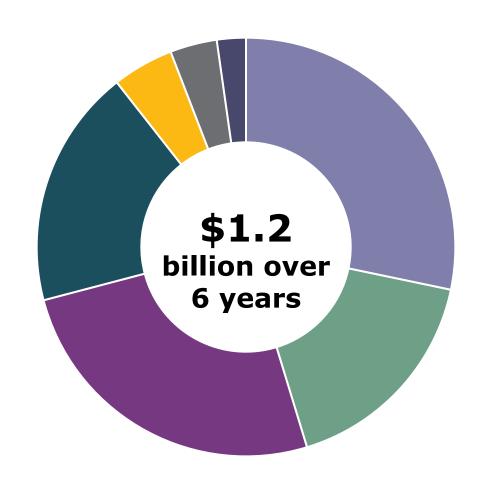
History of Major CIP Expenditures

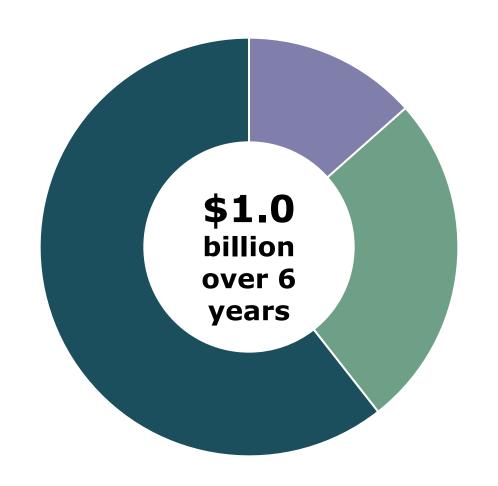
