METHODS TO REGISTER
Online: WebTrac is PRCS's online registration system. Before your camp registration date, new households should create an account or existing households check they can login. Visit www.loudoun.gov/webtrac or contact PRCS if you need help: 703-777-0343 or prcs@loudoun.gov

In Person: You can register in person at PRCS sites or visit PRCS Main Office at 742 Miller Drive, Leesburg, VA 20175

PAYMENTS
Registration fees are due at the time of registration, unless otherwise noted. Online registrations must be paid by credit card. Cash, check, money order or credit card payments can be made in person. Checks or money orders must be made payable to "County of Loudoun." Your driver's license number must be included on the check.

If a supply fee is noted for your camp, do not include it in your registration payment. Supply fees are payable to the instructor at the first day of camp. Licensed camps require a \$25 non-refundable deposit at the time of registration that goes towards the remaining balance to be paid 3 weeks before camp starts.

All licensed full-day camps offer a 50% discount for any family that is eligible for the free and reduced lunch program.

NOTICE TO PARTICIPANTS
All activities of a physical nature involve some risk. By registering for a county-sponsored class requiring -physical activity, you, as the participant or parent of a participant under the age of 18, assume the risk involved in participating in these activities. The Loudoun County Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services is dedicated to providing safe facilities and equipment for all participants, as well as qualified instructional staff to enhance your experience. Summer camps are coed, unless noted otherwise.

Unless specifically declined, by registering for or participating in a PRCS-sponsored activity, participants give permission for the Loudoun County Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services to use photographs and videos of themselves or their children for publicity in publications and other media, including social media, without limitation in order to increase community awareness of PRCS programs and services.

HOLIDAYS
Camps will not be held on Tuesday, July 4.

SUPPLIES & MATERIALS
The cost of supplies and materials is included in the camp fee, unless otherwise noted. If a separate supply or material fee is required, it must be paid to the instructor on the first day of camp.

PROGRAM ACCESSIBILITY/ADA
The Loudoun County Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services is committed to complying with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). If you require a reasonable accommodation for any type of disability to participate in PRCS activities, please email adaptrec@loudoun.gov.

ALLERGIES
If a child has an allergy, parents need to supply a complete list of what foods or allergens their child(ren) are allergic to and therefore need to be avoided. This information can be provided through the Participant Information Form with our licensed camps or parents can share information with the staff at the recreation and community centers, and parks.

PROGRAM REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS
Refund requests must be submitted in writing and include an explanation of why the participant is disappointed with the quality of the particular class/program. The written request should be dated and sent by email, fax, or mail directly to the location manager or program manager offering the class/program. If you are unsure whom to contact, please call our main office at 703-777-0343 and someone will direct you to the appropriate manager. Only written requests will be accepted. The amount of any refund will be prorated based on the number of remaining class/program sessions.

Our goal is to ensure quality programs. If you are dissatisfied with the quality of a class/program in which you are currently enrolled, you may request a refund according to the policy.

If you need to cancel a class/program registration, and you make the request 15 or more days before the start date, a full refund, MINUS a 15% administrative fee (maximum of \$15) or the program-specific deposit, will be offered. If you cancel a class/program registration 14 or fewer days before the start date, a refund of 50% will be offered. Cancellation requests must be submitted in writing. The request should be dated and sent by email, fax, or mail directly to the facility manager or program manager offering the class/program.

The Department reserves the right to cancel or change a class or activity due to insufficient enrollment or other reasonable cause. A full refund (including any applicable registration fee) will be offered.

GRADES

Fest follows the Commonwealth of Virginia DOE licensing guidelines. Children entering grades 6-8 in fall 2023 are eligible.

LOCATIONS
All Daze and Fest Camp locations will be confirmed online at www.loudoun.gov/camps no later than Wednesday, March 1, 2023. All Camp locations are subject to change, based on decisions from LCPS.

HOURS OF OPERATION
Daze and Fest camp programs run Tuesday, June 20 – Friday, August 11, and operate Monday – Friday from 7:30am-6:00pm. There is no camp Monday, July 3 or Tuesday, July 4.

MEALS & SNACKS
Campers must bring two snacks, a lunch, and a plastic water bottle daily - no glass bottles. Please provide shelf-stable items, as refrigerators will not be available at site.

- For New Registrants Only:**
- Acceptable forms of identity include a student's report card OR an original or certified copy of the child's birth certificate, birth registration card, or passport.
 - A copy of the student's report card OR a Commonwealth of Virginia School Entrance Health Form signed by a physician.

There are no exceptions. Forms not received by Friday, April 14, 2023, will result in being dropped from the program and required to re-register paying the applicable fees if space is available.

CANCELLATION POLICY
If you wish to cancel a week of camp, please email camp@loudoun.gov. As a reminder, the weekly deposit of \$25 is non-refundable and non-transferable. If you have made payment on a week of camp and cancel at least three weeks prior, you will receive the remaining balance you have paid. If you cancel with less than two weeks until that week of camp, you will receive 50% of the balance you have paid.
