

Loudoun County Electoral Board Policy Campaigning and Signs Outside the Office of Elections

- The grassy area to the left and right of the front entrance, which is 40' from the entrance, will be designated for campaigning only. The only campaign signs allowed in this area would be if they are affixed to a table or a tent.
- Each political party or independent candidate (without party endorsement) will be allowed one table on one side of the walkway.
- Campaign workers will be permitted to stand in the grassy area, along the sidewalk on the black bricks, and in the designated campaign areas of the parking lot.
- Stand-alone candidate campaign signs are <u>only</u> permitted on the grassy hillside area between Miller Drive and the parking lot. Campaign signs are limited to no more than 6 standard 18" x 24" yard signs per candidate. Candidates can start placing campaign signs at the Office of Elections no earlier than the day before early voting begins.
- See Office of Election staff for placement of tents outside the Office of Elections.
