### Day One, Sunday, April 21, 2024

Return to the hotel to rest and freshen up for another unforgettable and exclusive tonight. This evening, pull up in your luxury coach at **Grand Affairs** for the nautical themed **Mermaid Beach Bash!** The evening will begin with passed hors d'oeuvres with white glove service of scrumptious delights such as, Swedish cocktail meatballs, stuffed mushrooms, mini crab cakes, and cocktail shrimp shooters. But save room for the dinner buffet! #### Day Three, Tuesday, April 23, 2024

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before departing to spend the morning exploring Nauticus, The National Maritime Center, an exciting science and technology center highlighting the power of the sea. This high-tech, virtual reality "museum" allows visitors to explore the rich life of the ocean realm, human uses of the sea through shipping, and the role the port of Hampton Roads has played in world maritime affairs. You'll be astounded by the special effects of the "Living Sea" film, a movie taking you into the world of the Oceans! See humpback whales, golden jellyfish, and much more. Discover the Battleship USS Wisconsin, one of the largest Battleships ever built, the mighty ship was usedduring the Korean Conflict and the Gulf War. While visiting, don't forget to tour the Hampton Roads Naval Museum. The museum's mission is to study and interpret the history of the U.S. Navy in Hampton Roads. The museum oversees the day-to-day management and historic interpretation of the Battleship Wisconsin. Depart for free time and lunch on own at the Waterside Marketplace. Poised at the mouth of the Elizabeth River on Norfolk's downtown waterfront, The Waterside District houses major restaurants such as Guy Fieri's Smokehouse, Rappahannock Oyster Company, Cogan's Pizza, The Fudgery, Blue Moon Taphouse and much more. A \$40 million overhaul and rebranding of Norfolk's iconic Waterside Festival Marketplace allows visitors to enjoy national and local brands and concepts in an atmosphere that integrates the downtown with its waterfront. Later, visit the **Douglas MacArthur Memorial**, a museum and research center dedicated to preserving and presenting the story of the life of General of the Army, Douglas MacArthur. The Memorial also pays tribute to the millions of men and women who served with General MacArthur in World War I, World War II, and the Korean War. The Memorial consists of a museum, archive and research center, education center, theater, welcome center, and a gift shop. A visit to the Memorial will allow you to explore the life of one of America's greatest and most complex leaders. Explore the Chrysler Museum of Art and experience over fifty galleries, a growing collection of more than 30,000 objects, interactive spaces, and the only glass studio of its kind in the Mid-Atlantic region. Return to your hotel and delight with a relaxing free evening on the beach for dinner on own; a photo opportunity with King Neptune, a colossal 34-foot-high bronze statue that rises from the depths of the Atlantic Ocean at 31st Street & Atlantic Avenue, overlooking Neptune Park; or perhaps rent a bike and bike along the boardwalk, or pick up some famous, fresh-made Salt-water Taffy – the night is free to customize as you please and retire to your room at your leisure. #### Day Four, Wednesday, April 24, 2024

Enjoy **breakfast included** at the hotel this morning, prior to **checking-out**. Embark on a **Group Tram Tour** of the **Norfolk Botanical Gardens** and enjoy strolling along one of the largest collections of azaleas, camellias, and rhododendrons on the East Coast. See the 155-acre garden with canal boats, trackless train tours, 12 miles of pathways, and specialty themed gardens. Make one last stop to visit the **Mariner's Museum** in Newport News, for a guided tour and movie at *Explorers Theater*. Pieces and remains of the ironclad USS Monitor anchor this extensive museum exploring global maritime history. The museum seeks to connect people to the world's waters. (**Meals: B, L**)
