

At a business meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Loudoun County, Virginia, held in the County Government Center, Board of Supervisors' Meeting Room, 1 Harrison St., S.E., Leesburg, Virginia, on Tuesday, July 5, 2022, at 5:00 p.m.

IN RE: CPAM-2021-0002, US Route 15 North – Widening and Safety Improvements (Catoctin)

Supervisor Kershner moved that the Board of Supervisors approve CPAM-2021-0002, US Route 15 North –Widening and Safety Improvements, as presented in Attachments 1 and 2 to the July 5, 2022, Board of Supervisors Business Meeting Action Item, subject to revising Roadway Locational Note U on Attachment 1 to read as follows "Per CPAM 2021-0002, the widening of Route 15 includes a planned bypass around the Village of Lucketts. Final alignment of the bypass shall be west of existing Route 15 and the number of lanes south of Stumptown Road will be determined on the basis of a formal project alternatives study to be performed in conjunction with project design."

Supervisor Kershner further moved that staff present to the Board of Supervisors, not later than the October 18, 2022, Board of Supervisors business meeting, a list of safety and operational improvements that can reasonably be completed within seven years from the date of passage of the Route 15 North CPAM (CPAM-2021-0002). The list will include a description of each proposed safety and operational improvement, prioritized by the most beneficial to the least beneficial in terms of improving corridor safety and reliability. In addition, the list will include the estimated time to complete and estimated total cost when constructed and will be forwarded for consideration in the FY 2024 CIP budget development process.
