2024 Spring Grant Cohort Application Guidance

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Spring Grant Cohort Description

Nonprofit organizations that serve Loudoun County residents are encouraged to apply for the Spring Professional Development Grant Cohort, which will explore the various facets of government grant seeking and proposal development. Participants will develop proposals in response to relevant funding notices over a series of training sessions in a six-week period in May and June. At the end of the six weeks, organizations will have a complete set of standard proposal components and a tailored application package for a relevant state or federal government funding opportunity for their organization. The training is free, but space is limited to five organizations. Nonprofits working to create a systematic development program are encouraged to apply.

Participant Outcomes

- Increased ability to:
 - Identify mission-aligned government NOFOs
 - Search government and non-government search engines using organization's programmatic key terms
 - Identify timelines and budget components that adhere to organization's internal programmatic planning when searching for NOFOs
 - \circ $\;$ Identify key staff within organization to support grant application activities
- Increased ability to:
 - o Adhere to NOFO outline and required evaluation components
 - Develop proposal components that are tailored to NOFO
 - Use appropriate budget development and justification language aligned to NOFO allowable expenses
 - Articulate outcomes, objectives and activities that can be evaluated by third party

Attendance in this professional development opportunity does not guarantee funding, indicate a commitment to apply to grant opportunities, nor does it signify partnership with the County.

Application Schedule and Selection Criteria

- Cohort Application Release- April 11, 2024
- Cohort Applications Due- May 11, 2024
- Trainings Occur- May-June 2024

To be accepted into the ARPA Spring Grant Cohort, applicant organizations must:

- obtain executive leadership approval and commitment to apply for funding within the next year,
- be registered with Sam.gov and have an active Unique Entity Identifier,
- make a commitment to attend all trainings (across their organization),
- and attend a standalone grants session or watch a recording from a previous ARPA professional development training and fill in a questionnaire. *Participants may demonstrate previous skills and abilities in their application in lieu of training attendance.*

Application Details

Lead Applicant

One application per organization will be accepted. Organizations must designate a lead applicant to apply. Lead applicants should be an individual at an organization who takes part in grant seeking, writing, or management.

Pre-application the Lead Applicant is responsible for:

- completing the application,
- interfacing with the Program Evaluation and Research team at the County,
- coordinating participation across their organization,
- and securing executive leadership approval for participation.

Post-application acceptance the lead applicant is responsible for:

- ensuring participants attend relevant workshops, (All workshops must be attended by at least one person in the organization as a requirement of program participation.),
- coordinating assignments in completion of the mock RFP,
- coordinating the Peer Review at their organization.

Past Training Attendance

Past training attendance is a requirement in session participation. The lead applicant or one staff person who is participating, must have attended past grants trainings OR relevant grants trainings offered outside the county.


