Summer 2024 Senior Trips registration begins on Wednesday May 8th at 9:00am unless otherwise noted. All trips are for individuals 55+. Transportation is by 28-passenger bus or motor coach. First price listed is for current senior center members (Ashburn, Carver, Cascades, Dulles South, and Leesburg); second price listed is for non-members. For non-members who do not live in Loudoun County registration begins on 5/15/24.

Important Note: An update to our registration system will now recognize your membership status and charge you accordingly. If you have an expired membership, you will be charged non-member fees. For those non-county residents who are not members the system will not let you register until 5/15. If you are unsure about your membership status, please contact your Senior Center.

Departure and return locations for trips will alternate between Ashburn Senior Center, Cascades Senior Center, Dulles South Senior Center, and Carver Senior Center. All trips will include pick-up at the Floor & Decor Store (Old Walmart) 950 Edwards Ferry Road (west side of parking lot). **Please arrive at the departure location 5 to 10 minutes early. Bus will leave at the scheduled time.** Return times are estimates and may vary. Sign-up is required at any PRCS Senior, Community or Recreation Centers or online through PRCSconnect (day trips only). Registration for overnight trips is done in person.

The Loudoun County Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services (PRCS) is committed to complying with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). If you need an accommodation to participate in a Senior Trip or if you will be bringing a scooter or wheelchair to participate in a Senior Trip notification is required at least five days before registration opens.
