Loudoun County CHIP 2013 Annual Evaluation Report

January 9, 2014

Background: Loudoun County entered into the Mobilizing for Action through Planning and Partnerships (MAPP) strategic planning process in 2008 through the completion of four assessments to better identify the health needs of our community and to improve the health of those served by Loudoun County's governments, nonprofit organizations and businesses. The resulting data from these assessments were examined by the Loudoun County Health Department (LCHD) and Loudoun Health Council as part of MAPP's Action Cycle and the following four priority issues were identified in its January 2012 Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP), available at www.loudoun.gov/healthcheck:

- Increasing Access to and Timely Utilization of Health Care Services
- Ensuring a Safe, Healthy and Accessible Environment
- Improving Nutrition and Physical Activity
- Promoting Healthy Families in Healthy Communities

LCHD and the Health Council worked closely with the Loudoun County Board of Supervisors (BOS) and on July 3, 2012 the BOS endorsed the following Health Council initiatives beginning with state fiscal year 2013 (FY13), which constitute the county's improvement strategies:

- Educate Community on Steps Residents Can Take to Stay Safe From Lyme Disease
- Increase Awareness of the Importance of Drinking Safe Well Water
- Promote the Value of Children and Adults Receiving Preventive Health Services, With a Focus on Dental Health
- Reduce Gaps and Duplication of Services Among Safety Net Providers
- Promote Healthy Food Choices by Identifying and Increasing Available Community Resources

In July 2012, a work plan was developed to track the key proposed actions and activities, and to monitor progress in meeting performance measures developed in support of each CHIP initiative. This work plan was revised in October 2012 and forms the basis of annual progress reporting at the end of each calendar year, as the County works through its Improvement Plan Action Cycle. The first year of Loudoun's CHIP, reported as the Loudoun County CHIP 2012 Annual Evaluation Report (dated December 5, 2012), showed significant progress towards its implementation, with the Loudoun Health

Council particularly focused on successfully implementing the CHIP's initiatives and improvement strategies.

Loudoun County embarked on a new MAPP process in 2013, with results expected in early 2014.

Progress: The second year of Loudoun's CHIP has shown significant progress towards its implementation in several areas. Progress has been particularly strong in support of Ensuring a Safe, Healthy and Accessible Environment (Issue 2), where the initiatives to increase awareness of Lyme disease, safe drinking well water, onsite septic system maintenance, and alternative means of transportation have been completed. Additionally the county's annual Health for Life day event, Health Check survey and social media sites were excellent opportunities to promote healthy food choices, increase awareness of childhood obesity, domestic child and adult abuse, and increase awareness of available community activities and preventive health services to Loudoun County residents.

The initiative to reduce gaps and duplication of services among safety net providers has been postponed. The Loudoun Health Council was very active this past year in evaluating this issue. After multiple work group meetings, though, it was determined that this initiative should be postponed pending further direction from the full Health Council and feedback from the county's 2013 MAPP process.

Several initiatives are still pending that the county is actively pursuing, including information on preventive health services that can be distributed to Loudoun County residents (Issue 1), improving awareness of healthy food choices (Issue 3), partnering with realtors to improve awareness of community events with new residents (Issue 4), and partnering with those involved in domestic, child and adult abuse (Issue 4).

Assessment and Next Steps: During the second year of its Improvement Plan Action Cycle, Loudoun County has continued making significant progress towards addressing the CHIP's four priority issues and the Board of Supervisors five county improvement strategies. Progress has continued being particularly strong in providing information to the public, in addressing Lyme disease, and in laying the groundwork for future progress. In some areas, particularly related to Promoting Healthy Families in Healthy Communities and in reducing gaps and duplication of services among safety net providers, target completion dates proved to be overly ambitious or the initiatives may need to be reevaluated.

The completion of Loudoun County's 2013 MAPP process in early 2014 is expected to significantly impact the CHIP's four priority issues and its initiative/improvement strategies. The Loudoun Health Council and Health Department will be evaluating the new MAPP assessments over the course of the year and will incorporate these changes into the 2014 CHIP Annual Evaluation Report.
